Statement on the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

Dear valued Business Partner,

Endress+Hauser is actively implementing Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR). The regulation strengthens the requirements for packaging across the EU, including substances of concern, recyclability, minimization, labelling, reporting and documentation obligations.

Based on the information currently available from our upstream supply chain, Endress+Hauser considers the relevant packaging used for our products to be in conformity with the initial PPWR requirements applicable from 12 August 2026.

Endress+Hauser entities are registered, where required, in country-specific packaging databases such as the German LUCID Packaging Register and follow the corresponding statutory registration, participation and reporting obligations.

Required Declarations of Conformity (DoCs) for packaging are retained internally from 12 August 2026 from our Product Centers. As a standard process, DoCs are not publicly made available but are kept as compliance evidence for competent authorities in the context of regulatory audits and inspections.

An exception may apply whereas you as a customer act as a distributor, for example as a plant manufacturer or dealer. In such cases, DoCs may be provided upon request if required for your own compliance obligations and only after a valid non-disclosure agreement (NDA) has been concluded.

We will continue to monitor legal developments, supplier information and national implementation requirements and will update our internal processes and customer information accordingly.
